





Show and Tell: When it is your child's turn for Show and Tell they will be given the Show and Tell bag the week before, in readiness for them to participate in Show and Tell on that same day, of the following week. Your child can bring an item that fits in the bag to talk about or they can do "talking" news and tell us about a recent adventure. Show and Tell will commence during February.

Little Endeavours: Get ready for lots of fun and learning as Jo starts the Little Endeavours Programme from February. Exploring, experimenting, creating, sharing and working together - Little Endeavours and especially time spent with Jo is a highlight for the children.

Preschool Accounts for 2019



On your arrival at Preschool your first invoice for the year will be in your parent pocket. This invoice will include fees for the first 4 weeks of Preschool and is due for payment by Friday, February 1st. Week commencing February 4th, you will receive your first fortnightly invoice (via email) and we are then in our fortnightly in advance payment cycle. Once we are into the fortnightly fee system, many parents elect to set up automatic funds transfer from their bank account to ours (banking details are found on your statement). If you do this please set up the payment for the **Thursday prior to the Friday due date** to ensure payment is recorded on our statement prior to the following Monday morning, when the next invoice is raised. This will avoid any unnecessary confusion of entries on your statement. We only accept payment via direct deposit or cheque, we do not accept cash payments for fees.

Please also ensure we have the correct email address on file to ensure you receive your fortnightly accounts.

Please note if your account does not display the child care benefit you were expecting then it is possible that your child is not correctly linked to your family assessment within the centrelink system and you will be charged full fees until this has been processed at their end. Please check your online application or contact Centrelink to rectify.




